

ADDENDUM NO. 2

Round Mountain 2026 Timber Operations | RFP No. YWI-RFP-2026-02

Issued September 1, 2026 by Yuba Watershed Institute

Purpose

This Addendum amends the Request for Proposals for the Round Mountain 2026 Timber Operations, issued August 14, 2026 and previously amended by Addendum No. 1 on August 31, 2026.

A proposer asked whether the Licensed Timber Operator Class A (LTO-A) certification satisfies the separate “contractor’s license” item in the RFP’s licensing requirement, or whether a Contractors State License Board (CSLB) classification is required. The question was received after the August 26, 2026 question deadline. Because the licensing requirement is a pass or fail condition that bears on whether a proposal can be accepted at all, YWI is answering it by addendum so that every proposer receives the same information.

Effect on the schedule

None. Proposals remain due September 14, 2026 at 5:00 p.m. Pacific. All other dates in RFP Section II are unchanged.

Acknowledgment required

Proposers shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum on the Cost Proposal Form at Exhibit F, in the space provided for Addenda No. ____ through _____. A proposal that does not acknowledge Addenda No. 1 and No. 2 may be rejected as non-responsive.

Item 1 — RFP, Section III.E, paragraph 6, “Licenses”

Delete:

6. Licenses. Provide proof of California business license, contractor’s license, and valid LTO-A certification.

Insert:

6. Licenses. Provide proof of a California business license and of a current and valid Licensed Timber Operator Class A (LTO-A) certification in good standing with the

California Board of Forestry and Fire Protection. For purposes of this solicitation, a Contractors State License Board classification is not separately required, and the LTO-A certification satisfies the licensing requirement for the timber operations described in Exhibit B. Nothing in this paragraph relieves the Contractor of its obligation under Section 2.11(e) of the Contract to secure all licenses and permits, and to file all notices, required by law in connection with its performance.

Item 2 — RFP, Section IV.A, “Pass or fail”

Delete:

- Proof of California business license, contractor’s license, and valid LTO-A certification

Insert:

- Proof of a California business license and of a current and valid Licensed Timber Operator Class A (LTO-A) certification in good standing with the California Board of Forestry and Fire Protection

What has not changed

Section 2.10(b) of the Contract at Exhibit G is unchanged. The Operator must hold a current and active Licensed Timber Operator Class A license in good standing, all required licenses and permits for commercial vehicle operations, and a county or state highway encroachment permit if one is needed.

Section 2.11(e) of the Contract is unchanged. Except for the permits YWI and the Landowner are responsible for under Section 2.10(a), the Operator secures all licenses and permits and files all notices required by law relating to its performance, and provides YWI evidence of compliance on request.

The successful proposer must also be amended onto MTHP #2-23-00126-NEV before operations begin, as provided in Exhibit B, Section 1.
